PROSPECTUS.

I.—Cet établissement, sous la direction des Religieux de la Congrégation de Sainte-Croix, fut fondé en 1864 et incorporé en 1868. Un acte du parlement l'autorise à conférer les Degrés aux élèves finissant leurs études.

II.—Le Cours d'Etude, dans lequel l'Instruction religieuse tient le premier rang, se divise en deux sections : Le Cours Commercial et le Cours Classique. Les langues Française et Anglaise y sont l'objet d'une égale sollicitude.

III.—Le Cours Commercial a pour but de préparer les jeunes gens à la carrière du commerce. Il comprend cinq classes, savoir : LE COURS SPÉCIAL ; LA QUATRIÈME, LA TROISIÈME, LA DEUXIÈME, LA PREMIÈRE. Les matières purement commerciales, telles que la Tenue des Livres et l'Arithmétique, ne sont enseignées qu'en Anglais. Des diplômes sont décernés aux élèves qui subissent des examens satisfaisants sur les diverses branches enseignées dans ce cours.

IV.—L'objet du Cours Classique est de mettre les jeunes gens en état de se livrer avec avantage à l'étude des diverses professions libérales. Il comprend cinq classes, savoir : Les ÉLÉMENTS et la SYNTAXE, la MÉTHODE et la VERSIFICATION, les BELLES LETTRES, la RHÉTORIQUE, et la PHILOSOPHIE. Aucun élève n'est admis à l'étude du Latin sans avoir préalablement suivi le Cours Commercial en entier. L'instruction classique sera assaisonnée de l'esprit chrétien et interprétée au point de vue religieux.

DEGRES.

Le programme des études classiques a dernièrement été revu et modifié. Pour répondre aux besoins de l'époque, on

a introduit certaines matières nouvelles et on donnera désormais une attention plus soignée à d'autres qui, jusqu'à ce jour, n'étaient considérées que comme secondaires. Le nouveau programme a donc été dressé de manière à rencontrer ces divers besoins, et, vu ces modifications, la Fauchéte enseignante conférera à l'avenir aux élèves qui auront terminé leur cours les Degrés de Bachelier-ès-Lettres, Bachelier-ès-Sciences, et Bachelier-ès-Arts. La Classe d'Eléments et de Syntaxe de 1883-84 a suivi le nouveau programme, qui sera désormais le seul suivi dans la maison. En conséquence, la classe de Philosophie de 1887-88 et leurs successeurs recevront, après des examens satisfaisants, les Degrés de B.L., B.S., ou B.A.

Les lettres et envois adressés aux élèves, ou expédiés par eux, sont soumis à l'inspection du président ou de son délégué.

Les parents recevront, chaque trimestre, un bulletin constatant les progrès, l'application, la conduite et la santé de leurs enfants, ainsi que le montant de leurs dépenses.

Les élèves qui n'arrivent qu'après la rentrée régulière, ont droit à une réduction de prix pour le temps écoulé; mais un mois commencé doit être payé en entier.

On reçoit des élèves à toute époque de l'année.

Des Religieuses donnent leur attention au soin et à la propreté des jeunes enfants aussi bien qu'au linge des élèves en général.

Les demi-pensionnaires couchent au collège et paient 50 centins pour l'usage du lit.

PROSPECTUS.

I.—This Institution is conducted by the Fathers of the Congregation of Holy Cross. Founded in 1864, it was incorporated, with power to confer Degrees, by an Act of the Provincial Parliament in 1868.

II.—The studies, among which Religious Instruction stands pre-eminent, are divided into two Courses: the Commercial, and the Classical. The English, and the French language are taught with equal care.

III.—The Commercial Course is designed to fit young men for a business life. It comprises four classes: THIRD, SECOND AND FIRST ENGLISH, AND BUSINESS CLASS. Diplomas are

awarded to those students of the course who pass satisfactory examinations on practical commerce, and the various branches pertaining thereto.

IV.—The object of the Classical Course is to enable young men profitably to pursue the special studies required for any of the liberal professions. It comprises five classes : ELEMENTS AND SYNTAX, VERSIFICATION, BELLES LETTRES, RHETORIC, AND PHILOSOPHY. No student is admitted to the study of the Classics before he has completed his Commercial Course, exclusive of Business Class. Classical instruction is imparted in a thoroughly Christian spirit.

DEGREES.

The Programme of Studies in the Classical Course has lately been revised and improved. The requirements of the age have necessitated the introduction of some branches, and a more thorough treatment of others which, in the old curriculum, held only a secondary rank. The new programme has been adopted in order to meet these requirements ; and its completeness is such as to warrant the Faculty in conferring, upon future graduates, the Degrees of Bachelor of Literature, Bachelor of Science, and Bachelor of Arts. The Elements and Syntax Class of 1883-84 have followed this revised programme, and will continue to do so throughout their entire course. The Philosophy Class, therefore, of 1887-88, and the graduates of all following years, will receive, provided their different examinations shall have been satisfactorily passed, the Degree of B.L., B.S., or B.A.

Parents will receive, each quarter, bulletins of the progress, application, conduct and health of their children, as also a statement of their expenses.

Students entering after the beginning of the term are charged for the remaining portion only. No deduction, however, is made for a month already commenced. Students are received at any time during the year.

Nuns devote their attention to the cleanliness and well-being of young children, and are also charged with the care of the students' linen.
